TOURNAMENT RULES

1. No metal spikes allowed
2. All bases will be sixty-five (65) feet apart
3. Pitchers may pitch from forty-six (46) or fifty (50) feet
4. Home plate is always live
5. Suicide line will be twenty (20) feet from the home plate with a line at home plate. Runners must not touch home plate – if touch plate – automatic out – no tagging of runner at home plate
6. Unlimited substitution
7. There must be a minimum of nine (9) players to start a game but tenth (10) player will be considered an out. Tenth (10) and additional players may enter game after next complete half inning.
8. Minimum arc will be six (6) feet from the ground with no maximum arc
9. Three (3) courtesy runners, anytime, anywhere. Additional runners for injury by agreement of both teams and must be last out.
10. Umpire decisions are final!
11. ASA APPROVED BATS ONLY. LIST IS AVAILABLE AT http://www.asasoftball.com/about/certified_equipment.asp
12. Home team decided by a coin toss and home team will be the official scorer for the game.
13. Five (5) warm-up pitches before game and one (1) pitch between innings
14. Games shall last seven (7) innings or 1 hour 15 minutes except tied scores when sudden death applies or unless terminated by the umpire(s) or any time after five (5) complete innings where one team has a ten (10) runs or greater differential. No time limit.
15. No infield practices.
16. No player shall play for more than one team during the tournament.
17. Fourth (4) strike foul is an “out”
18. Maximum five (5) homeruns per game per team. Any batter hitting a homerun after five (5) homeruns have been hit, the batter is out and all runners return to their original base. A homerun is any ball that is hit over the fence in fair territory in which no fielder has touched the ball.
19. Members of the CDCF or TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE and their affiliates will not be held responsible for incidents that happen during the tournament. Play responsibly and at your own risk..
20. Teams shall be ready to begin fifteen (15) minutes before scheduled start times. Teams will forfeit the game if not able to field a team ten (10) minutes after start time.
21. Personal alcohol will be confined to designated camping areas. No trunk bars in the rest of the park. Teams not respecting this rule will be eliminated from the tournament with no refunds. The continued success of this tournament is dependant on your continued support of the CDCF facilities.
